Statement on "Freedom Rallies" from Mennonite Church Canada's executive ministers "As leaders within Mennonite Church Canada, we unequivocally denounce the symbols, words and actions of white nationalism being expressed in Ottawa and across the country at "Freedom Rallies." While we support the right of people to gather peacefully in protest of government laws perceived to be unjust, we cannot support any action that promotes anti-Semitism, Islamophobia or racism. Jesus calls us to love our neighbours as ourselves as an expression of our love for God (Mark 12:29-31), across categories of race, ethnicity, religion and gender (Luke 10:25-37; Gal 3:28). We call on all Christians to walk in Jesus' way of love."

A Message from Micah Mission, Saskatoon:

At the end of March, the project that provided Federal funding for Micah Mission and 14 other sites across Canada to run Circles of Support and Accountability (CoSA) will come to an end. This raises concerns for the Micah Mission as we seek to find ways to continue this important program.

The mission of CoSA is to substantially reduce the risk of future sexual victimization by assisting and supporting released individuals in their task of integrating into the community and leading a responsible, meaningful, and accountable life.

Thankfully, staff and volunteers in the CoSA Canada office in Ottawa have been lobbying people in government and thus far have been meeting with favourable responses and support. We hope and pray that this will translate into more federal dollars being directed to the CoSA sites.

Micah Mission, and other CoSA, are also seeking to support MPs in choosing continued support of restorative justice and particularly CoSA.
