**Points of Progress**

- 1) **Azerbaijan and Tajikistan: The WHO has certified Azerbaijan and Tajikistan free of malaria.** Azerbaijan last had a case of malaria in 2012. Tajikistan saw its last case in 2014.
- 2) **Mozambique: Warning systems saved lives during Tropical Cyclone Freddy, the most energetic and longest cyclone ever recorded.** Radio and TV announcements, cars with loudspeakers, and text messages were all deployed to warn residents and tell them where to seek shelter ahead of the storm. The UN and the World Meteorological Organization consider early warning systems and early action to be critical adaptations as storms become more powerful due to climate change.
