Points of Progress

Senegal: Women are donning beekeeping gear to protect mangroves, boosting a critical habitat and their own livelihoods. Senegal has lost about 30% of its mangrove cover since 1950 due to climate change. To allow the mangroves "to rest", a cooperative of 67 women is tending hives, who bees help pollinate the mangroves.

Tuvalu: With 3D scans of all 124 islands and islets complete, Tuvalu's effort to create a digital nation is preserving the country's heritage amid the rising sea levels that threaten it. Scientists say rising tides could render the nation uninhabitable by 2100.
