Our Coins Count begins this Sunday. This year, the proceeds will go to Mennonite Central Committee and their partners in Bangladesh to develop food and nutrition programs among impoverished and marginalized Indigenous groups in northern Bangladesh. \$10 provides one guava, lemon, olive, or papaya tree; \$25 provides vaccinations for 25 chickens; \$60 provides seed saving for 25 people; \$130 provides vocational training for one person for a year.
